

## GRINDLETON HORTICULTURAL SHOW 2017

The show will be held on **Sunday 27th August** at the **Grindleton Pavilion**.

### Who can enter?

Residents of Grindleton, and those with a connection to the village such as membership of a Grindleton based group or organisation. And you do not have to be present on the day of the show to enter. Many of the classes are for items that can be made in advance and brought in on your behalf by a friend.

### What are the classes?

The schedule covers a wide range of entries: Flowers & Floral Art; Vegetables & Fruit; Home Baking & Preserves; Photography & Craft. We look for things that will appeal to a variety of interests and ages.

### Can Young People enter?

We encourage young people to enter and judges take age into consideration when awarding prizes. This year we have two activities that should appeal to young people. The first is to create a small self propelled vehicle that can transport an egg. This can be an individual entry by a youngster (Age 16 or under), or a group or family entry in which a young person is part of the group. The vehicle will firstly be judged on its ingenuity and appearance. In the afternoon, when the show is open to visitors, there will be a contest to find which vehicles can travel the farthest. Also during the afternoon children will be able to compete for a prize by creating a "face on a plate" from materials supplied.

### How do I enter?

The Schedule/Entry Form can be picked up at the Grindleton Pavilion or can be downloaded from the Grindleton Village website [www.grindleton.org](http://www.grindleton.org). If you have difficulties getting a schedule contact one of the people listed below. There is a small charge of 10 pence per entry. Entry forms can be submitted at any time prior to the show but no later than 5:00 p.m. on Friday 25th August.

### The timetable on the day of the show is:

Between **9:00 and 11:00** entries are brought to the Pavilion  
From **11:00 until 2:30** the venue is closed for judging  
At **2:30** the show is open for visitors and refreshments are available  
At **3:30** the raffle is drawn and announcements are made. This is followed by Sale of donated entries, and Pimms on the Patio.

All profits from the Horticultural Show are in aid of the Grindleton Recreation Ground Charity which provides village based recreational amenities for all ages.

We hope that you will enter something in the show. It has become a firm part of the village calendar and is well worth attending for the afternoon tea and cakes. You can also enjoy a glass of Pimms on the patio.
