The Parish Council have agreed not to hold any further face to face contact meetings until September due to the Coronavirus Pandemic Restrictions. However, there have been issues that have been addressed electronically since the last meeting.

1. Speeding Restrictions

Letter received from Dave Hartley regarding reducing speed through the village to 20mph. GPC wrote to LCC Highways. Received response. GPC – agree to direct people's concerns to the correct area for traffic issues. GPC replied to Dave Hartley with response.

2. Speedbump at Crossfold

Letter received from Stephen Bialecki regarding construction of speedbump on Crossfold. GPC's response – private matter as on unadopted road. Replied to Mr Bialecki

3. Toilet Tax

GPC responded to questionnaire in support of Toilet Tax to support other Parishes.

4. Planning Application – Duke of York

GPC has objected to recent planning application re-submitted for the Duke of York.

5. LALC membership

GPC agreed to pay £175.56 for LALC membership.

6. Grindleton Support during Coronavirus

Cllr Halley has been overseeing a group of volunteers to help with shopping etc for those residents who are self-isolating. Also has organised distribution of Prescriptions. Notices for the above and Information regarding Parish Council meetings have been displayed on relevant websites and the notice board.

7. New Website

Graham Cooper has now finished the new website and has it up and running. Favourable comments so far. Letters of thanks sent to Graham and Jacob for all their hard work.

8. Cherry Trees

Two cherry trees purchased from Holden Clough. Cllr Hutton to oversee the planting. GPC agreed to pay by BACS £120 to Holden Clough for trees, compost and stakes. E Flatley and Cllr Entwistle to maintain watering of trees twice weekly.
