Pots or vases not to exceed 10" in diameter.

All pot plants should have been grown by the exhibitor or been in his/her possession for at least 6 months prior to the show,

- ☐ 2. Cacti or succulent
- ☐ 3. Flowering Pot Plant - in Bloom
- ☐ 4. Vase of Sweet Peas, 6 stems
- ☐ 5. Vase of 3 Dahlias
- ☐ 6. A spike of Gladioli
- ☐ 7. Vase of Cosmos
- ☐ 8. Bloom or Spike of Blooms, single variety not named above
- ☐ 9. Three stems of perennial blooms single variety not named above
- ☐ 10. Vase of any mixed garden flowers
- ☐ 11. One Spike Multi-flowered Rose, any variety
- ☐ 12. One Specimen Rose with foliage on stem

Floral Art Classes

No artificial plant material to be used

- ☐ 13. Arrangement on a Summer holiday theme. (Max 18"x18")
- ☐ 14. Arrangement in a recycled container
- ☐ 15. A hedgerow ring
- ☐ 16. Arrangement in a cup & saucer

Vegetable and Fruit Classes –

Entries should be washed – but not scrubbed

- ☐ 17. The heaviest Truss of Tomatoes, ripe or unripe
- ☐ 18. Plate of four ripe regular Tomatoes
- ☐ 19. Plate of four ripe cherry Tomatoes
- ☐ 20. Three matching onions (any size) dressed
- ☐ 21. Four Potatoes – white (any variety)
- ☐ 22. Four Potatoes – coloured (any variety)
- ☐ 23. A Brassica
- ☐ 24. Four Runner Beans
- ☐ 25. Three Leeks

Vegetables & Fruit (contd.)

- ☐ 26. Four Courgettes, (not exceeding 6" in length)
- ☐ 27. A Marrow
- ☐ 28. Three Radish – with roots and foliage
- ☐ 29. A Lettuce with washed root
- ☐ 30. A Cucumber (12" max)
- ☐ 31. Three Capsicums (Peppers or Chillies)
- ☐ 32. Mixed home-grown culinary herbs in a jam jar (herbs to be listed)
- ☐ 33. Funny/Ugly shaped fruit or vegetable
- ☐ 34. A root vegetable not mentioned above
- ☐ 35. A non-root vegetable not mentioned above
- ☐ 36. Three fruits, same variety (not soft)
- ☐ 37. A plate of soft fruit

Beverages

- ☐ 38. Home-made spirit-based drink
- ☐ 39. Home-made non-alcoholic drink

Preserves

- ☐ 40. Jar of Jam - fruit(s) to be named on label
- ☐ 41. Jar of Jelly – variety to be named on label

- ☐ 48. Victoria Sandwich Cake (Jam filling only)
- ☐ 49. Six decorated cup cakes (Adults only)
- ☐ 50. Date & Walnut cake (made in a loaf tin)
- ☐ 51. 3 gluten free biscuits
- ☐ 52. Chocolate Cake (Men Only)
